(SPAIN)

Flores De Cerezo

2015 Toro Tempranillo
Made w/ Biodynamically Grown Grapes

Young and fruit-driven w/ a nose of bright fruit and flowers. All wines here ferment with indigenous yeasts and this one matured in French barriques for six months before it was bottled in June 2016. The palate is juicy and fresh, with a slightly bittersweet, pleasant finish. Very good value."
