(ITALY)

La Perlina

Moscato Puglia

La Perlina, or "little pearl", is inspired by the mythical past of the Mediterranean, from the sailors of Homer's Odyssey to the Sirens that beckoned them. The sea was full of hope and danger, adventure and romance – qualities which animate this beautiful Moscato from Italy.

Made from hand-selected grapes grown on coveted, high-altitude sites. A delicately sweet white wine with soft, pearl-like bubbles.

"Bright golden straw color. Aromas and flavors of green nectarines, pressed linen, butter cream, and baked oak with a lively, finely carbonated, moderately sweet medium-to-full body and a delightful, fast finish with papery, cottony tannins and no oak. A refreshing and youthful dessert wine."

(ITALY)

Organic Extra Dry Prosecco DOC

Made from grapes cultivated without usage of chemical product nor synthetical fertilizers, it's produced from a vinification kept separate from other processes.

apple, pineapple and orange. Delicate bubbles and a creamy texture with notes of green apple, pineapple and clementine settle on the palate. Enjoy with gorgonzola with dates or figs, prosciutto with melon, seafood risotto, or as an aperitif.

"This golden straw colored Prosecco opens with a fruity grapefruit like bouquet with some floral notes. On the palate, this wine is light bodied, smooth and acidic. The flavor profile is mostly a fruity pear with hints of green apple. The finish is dry and its acidity lingers. The panel enjoyed this Prosecco and would pair it with baked haddock or chicken piccata."

Sparkling Rosé

Sophora symbolizes the natural beauty and excitement of New Zealand. Our premium vineyards are located in the Gisborne and Hawke's Bay districts of New Zealand's North Island, a classically cool climate region with maritime influenced and a long growing season. Pristine growing conditions and abundant sunshine enhances the vibrancy of our sparkling Rosé.

This wine is made from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir has an attractive pink blush color and luscious palate with a lasting, refreshing mousse. Delightful floral in aroma, fruitful in flavor, creamy in texture and quite refreshing. Winemaker Jane De Witt opted for a crowd-pleasing, slightly off-dry style that is ideal for sipping, but also accommodates pairing with food — everything from Sunday brunch fare to barbecued meats.

"Pleasing and pink, what a combination! The Sophora Sparkling Rose is seriously good; shows tart strawberries in its flavors and a firm, well built palate. Dry, but not overtly acidic. This is one of New Zealand's best efforts."
